

## Loans Services

Islington Education Library Service has more than 200,000 items in stock, including a unique collection of artefacts and costumes.

Our resources include books for all ages and in many languages, artefacts and costumes from around the world and from different eras, posters and professional resources.

Staff keep up to date with curriculum developments and are experienced at preparing loan collections. Our key aims are to support children's enjoyment of reading, creativity and independent learning.

## Consultancy Services

How good is your school library? Our advisory, training and consultancy services can bring your library up-to-date and help your students develop their library and research skills and love of reading.

We offer advice and training on:

- library organisation, furnishing, classification and cataloguing, stock audits and buying new books and library lessons
- best practice in creating classroom book corners
- use of learning resources in the classroom, including artefacts
- staffing the primary library.

Our Peripatetic Librarian Service provides trained library staff to work in school on a regular basis.



## Service Level Agreement

Schools can subscribe to the full range of services on offer in the form of a service level agreement. This is an annual buy-in arrangement negotiated with the school. A two-form entry school using their full entitlement will borrow resources with a value of at least £100,000 each year.

Each teacher completes a simple request form and will be entitled to half termly loans made to individual requirements of:

- 60 books and posters including 6 big books
- Artefact loan box including costumes
- Professional development resources

Resources are delivered and collected.

A variety of special loans are available for headteachers, school libraries, cross-curricular weeks and other school events.

## Pay as you go services

Individual teachers, non-subscribing schools and other organisations can pay for **individual boxes** or subscribe for particular year groups.

Delivery and collection can be arranged.
